Rovers provides great opportunities for fun, adventure, exploration and service. Rovers might find themselves planning a simple weekend camping trip or helping to organise an event involving thousands of people.

Rovers plan and host social activities such as balls, bush dances, 'Moots' (gatherings of Rovers on a local, national, and sometimes international level), so there are plenty of opportunities to socialise and meet new people.

## training for life

Rovers can earn a variety of qualifications in Business and Leadership through the Scouts Australia Institute of Training.

The Baden-Powell Scout Award is the highest award that can be achieved by Rovers. Its aim is to encourage Rovers to seek ways to widen their interests and extend their knowledge and experience.

Rovers is the oldest Youth section in the Scouting Movement for people between 17 – 25 years old. Rovers usually meet most weeks for about 2 hours.

Rover Crews can be comprised of members from your local area, town, city or further afield. Each Rover Crew is unique so you can find a group that shares your interests: from bush walking, canoeing, sailing, caving, ski-touring, canyoning, four-wheel driving, rock-climbing, scuba diving and theatre.

Rover Crews are self governing entities that plan and run their own programs and activities - older people are simply there to advise when necessary.

Joining Rovers is a great way to serve your local community and to also give service to younger people through Scouting.
